Example in Spanish: “Mesa” (table)

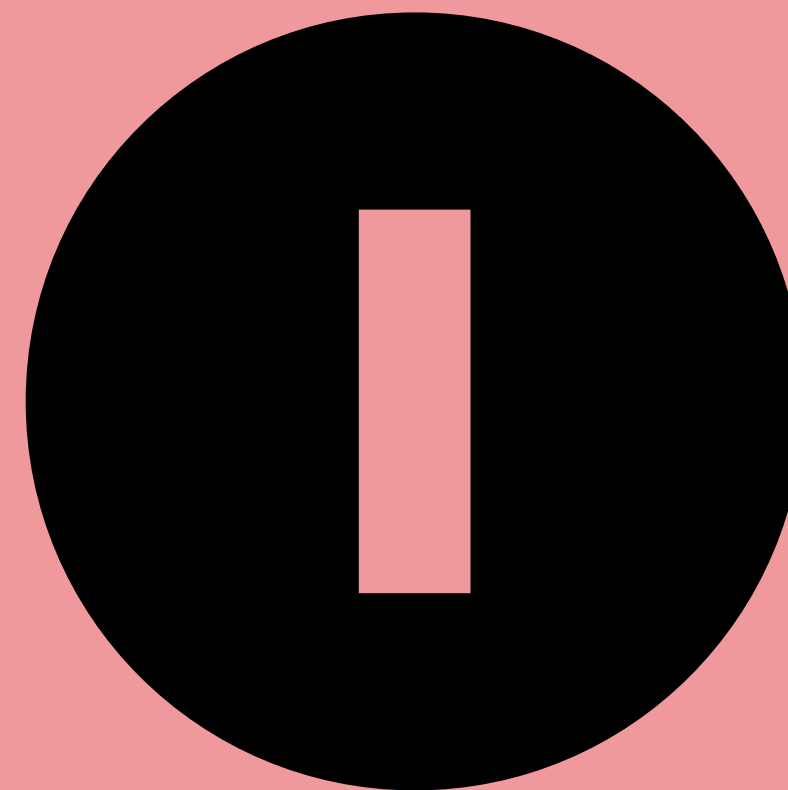


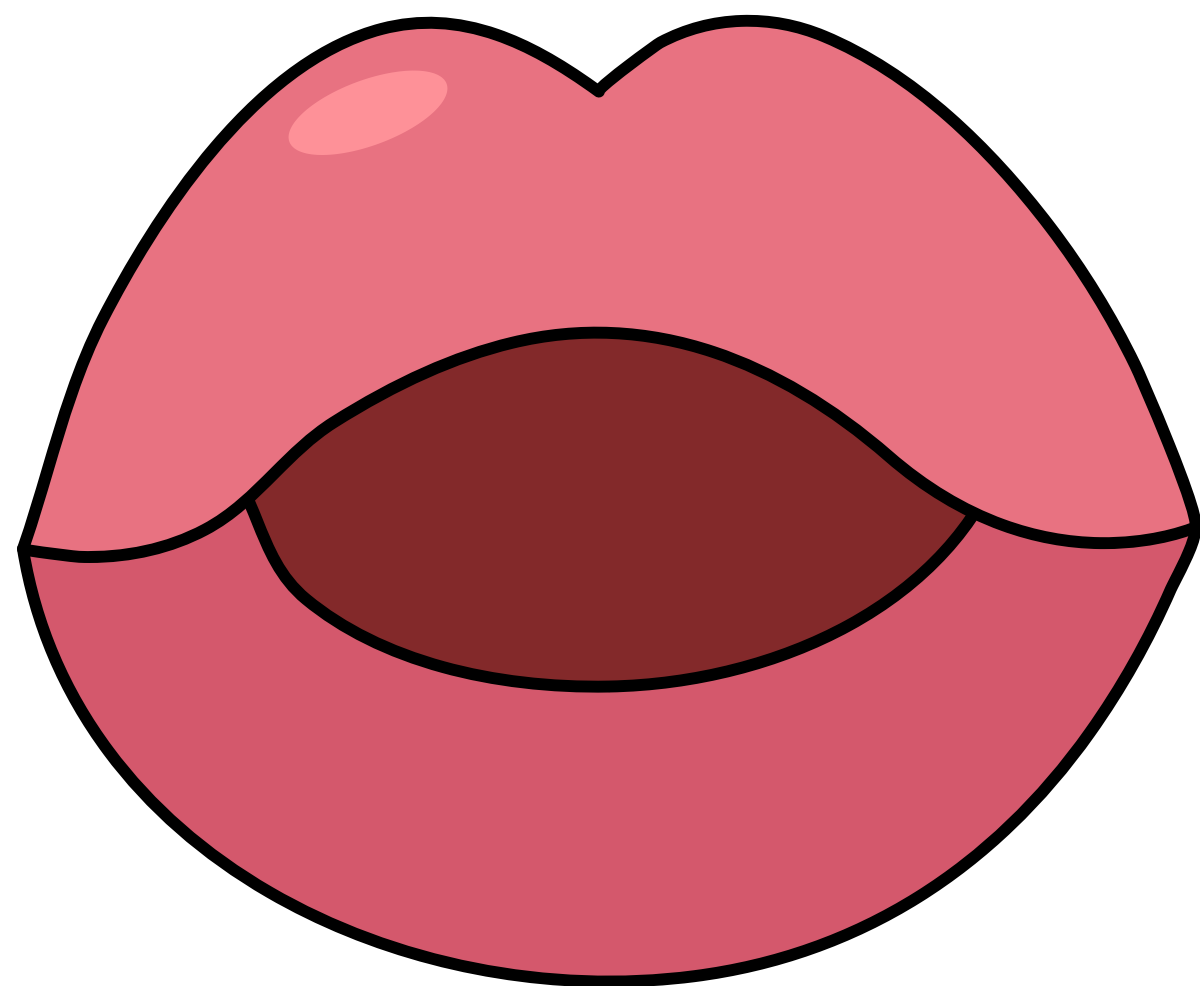

Example in Spanish: "Libro" (book)

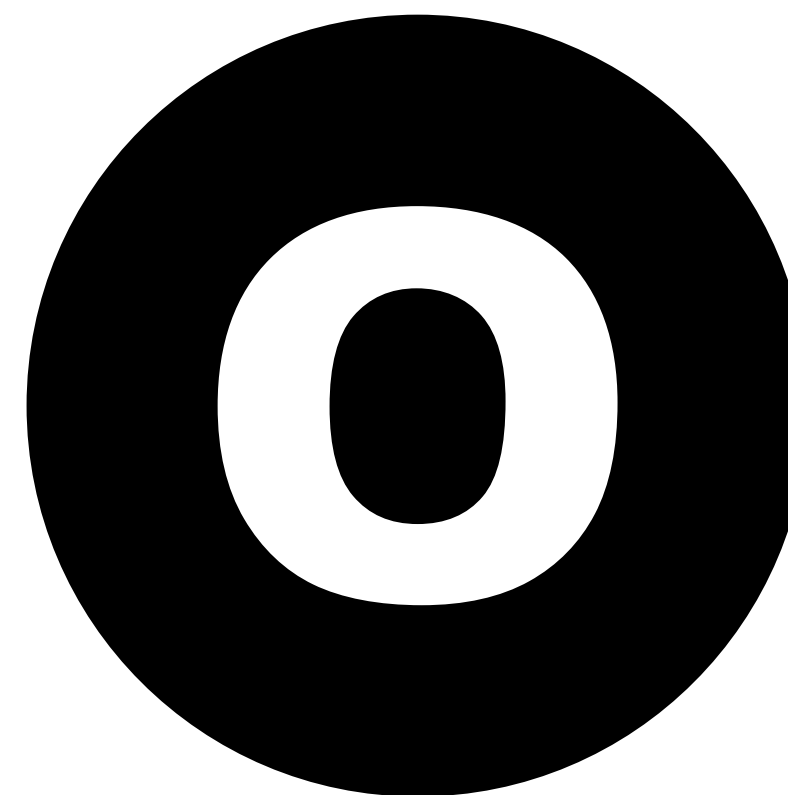


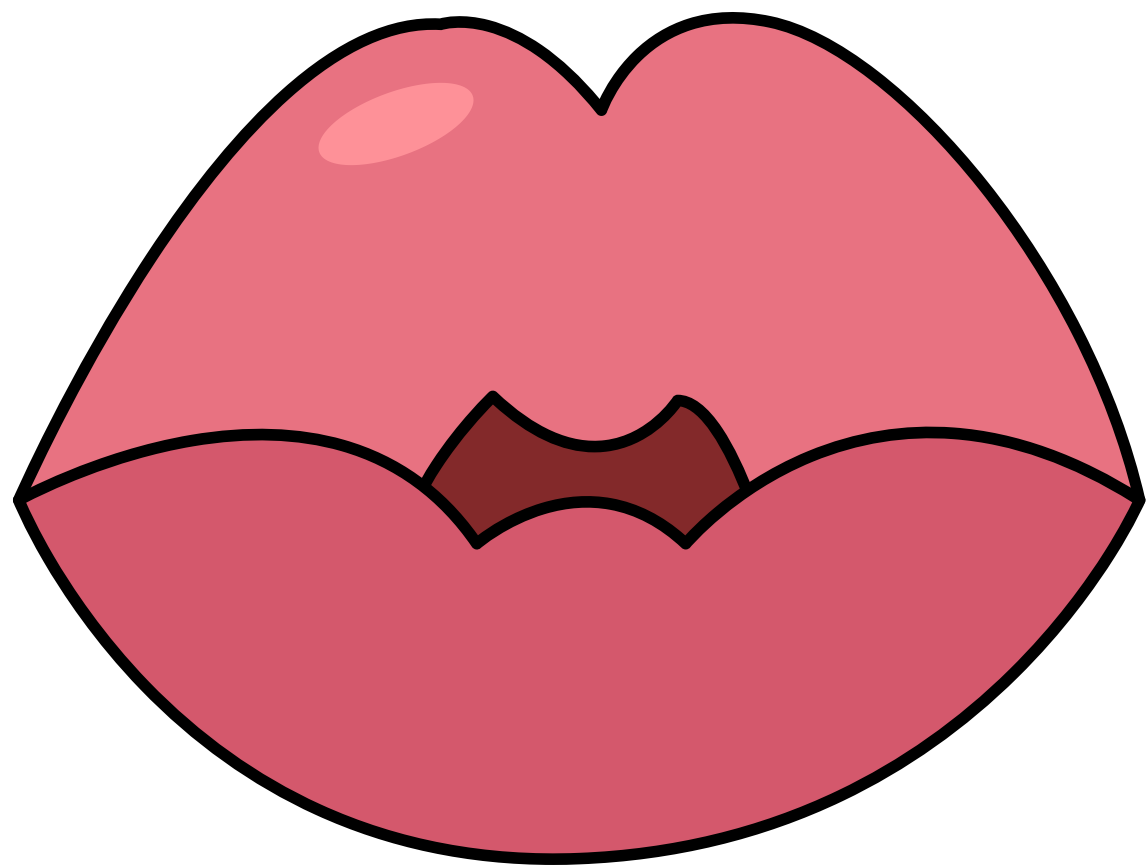


O (oh)
